Behavior	 Pays attention to an activity for 3-5 minutes at a time Transitions from one activity to another with visuals
Social/Emotional	 Uses 3+ word utterances to engage to with peers Engages in parallel play with classmates Begins to use play objects appropriately Begins to show an increasing variety of emotions
Gross Motor/Fine Motor	 Begins to climb one foot at a time Throws a ball overhand Starts to run Stands on tiptoes Carries a large toy while walking Uses a spoon and fork appropriately
